While she was pregnant with their second child, her husband became abusive and both were involved with drugs. Consequently, the marriage broke up and she was forced to give up her daughter and newborn son, Noah. Through her perseverance and help from Teen Challenge, she was able to get her children back. She married again and had twin sons Tristen and Hayne. They were born prematurely which required an extended stay in the hospital. However more abuse ensued and her mother was forced to step in and gave her an ultimatum – move in with her or all 4 of her children would be taken away. For the past 4 years, Amber and her children have been living with her mother in a very small home. Since the twins were born, Amber and her 4 children have all been sleeping in the same bedroom.

Amber has been clean and sober for five years now. Since neither father pays child support, Amber's family struggles financially. In 2012, she was able to purchase a used suburban that is now approaching 300,000 miles. The back window does not even go up. Amber is very active with her children and enjoys volunteering at their school. She embraces every opportunity to help her kids have a better life. The twins will begin pre-school in the fall which will allow her an opportunity to get a job to support her family.

Our goal for the Williams family is to get them a new car and to pay the insurance for one year.
